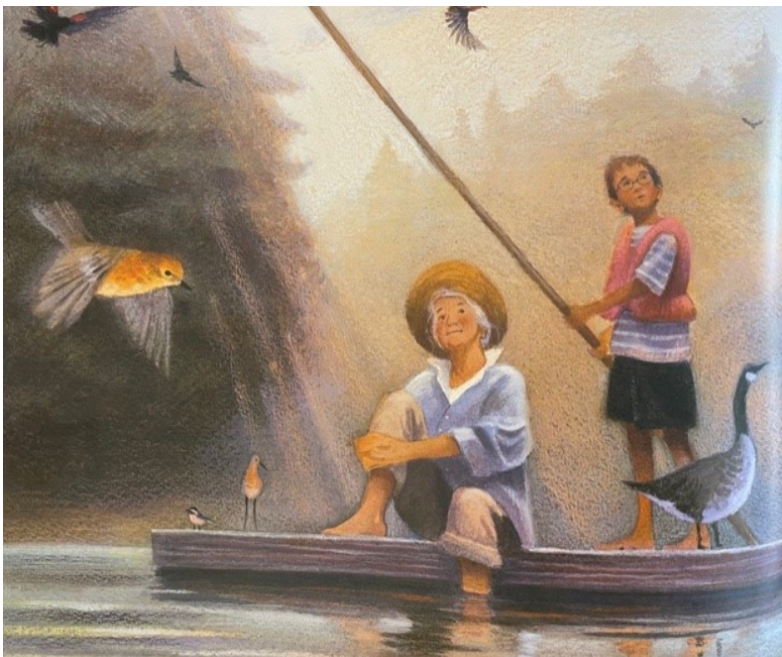

You can complete this at any time during the week, but I would recommend you complete it early on so that you can use the word in your writing.

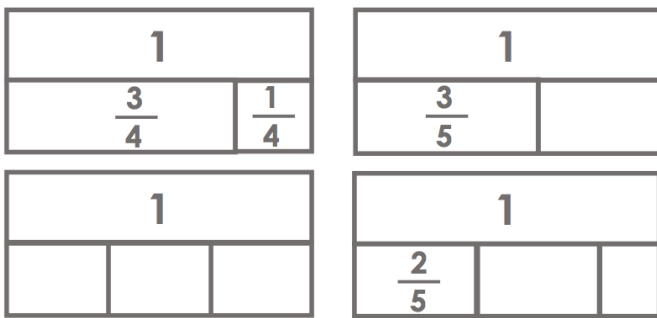
