$\frac{3}{4} + \frac{1}{8} = \frac{7}{8}$ $\frac{3}{5} + \frac{3}{10} = \frac{9}{10}$ $\frac{1}{3} + \frac{4}{9} = \frac{7}{9}$

Are these statements true or false? Prove it!

True	False
$\frac{5}{8} + \frac{1}{4} = \frac{7}{8}$ $\frac{5}{8} + \frac{2}{8} = \frac{7}{8}$	$\frac{2}{7} + \frac{2}{14} = \frac{4}{14}$ $\frac{4}{14} + \frac{2}{14} = \frac{6}{14}$
$\frac{3}{5} + \frac{1}{15} = \frac{10}{15}$ $\frac{9}{15} + \frac{1}{15} = \frac{10}{15}$	$\frac{2}{3} + \frac{1}{6} = \frac{3}{9}$ $\frac{4}{6} + \frac{1}{6} = \frac{5}{6}$
