- I **blinked** hard and **looked** out the window.

Does it improve the writing?

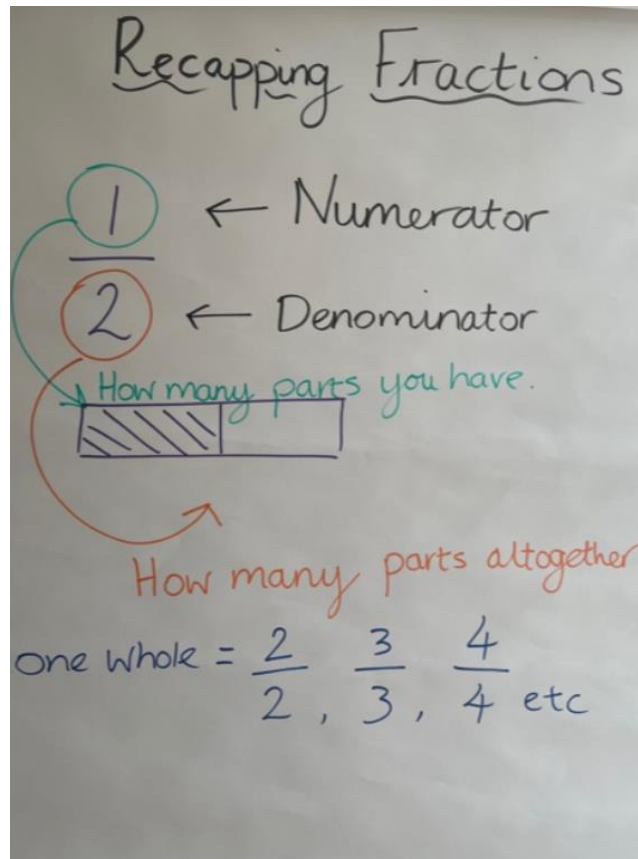
Finally think about some questions you would ask the characters.
