Look at the success criteria below:

<i>Does my first paragraph tell the reader something general to introduce the topic?</i>	
<i>Do my paragraphs contain information about the same topic and are they in a logical order?</i>	
<i>Have I included detail about special features?</i>	
<i>Does presentation make the information easy to locate? Underlined headings or subheadings, labels, CAPITALS, bold print, text boxes.</i>	
<i>Have I used some conjunctions to explain points further (so, because, also, when, which)?</i>	
<i>Have I used present tense and third person all the way through?</i>	
<i>Have I used:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>factual adjectives,</i><i>precise and formal nouns (humans, mammals),</i><i>modal verbs?</i>	

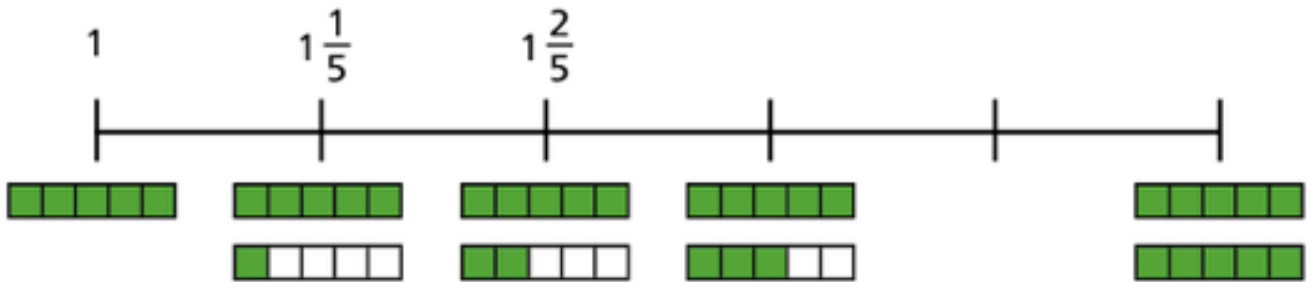

Starter: Practise your times tables and test yourself using the practise sheets on the website.

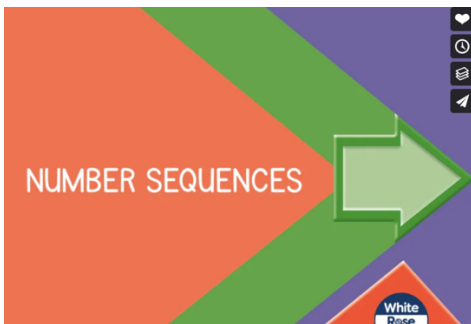
Today we will be learning about fractions in Number Sequences.
