

Extension Sheet Answers



1) *There are 2 possible answers:*

$$A = 7, B = 1 \quad \frac{7}{3} = 2\frac{1}{3}$$

$$A = 8, B = 2 \quad \frac{8}{3} = 2\frac{2}{3}$$

2) *Possible answers:*

$$A = 4, B = 1 \quad \frac{4}{3} = 1\frac{1}{3}$$

$$A = 7, B = 2 \quad \frac{7}{3} = 2\frac{1}{3}$$

$$A = 10, B = 3 \quad \frac{10}{3} = 3\frac{1}{3}$$

(In all answers that the children give, A should be one more than $B \times 3$.)

3) a) $\frac{18}{4} = 4\frac{2}{4}$

b) $\frac{28}{5} = 5\frac{3}{5}$

c) $\frac{13}{2} = 6\frac{1}{2}$
