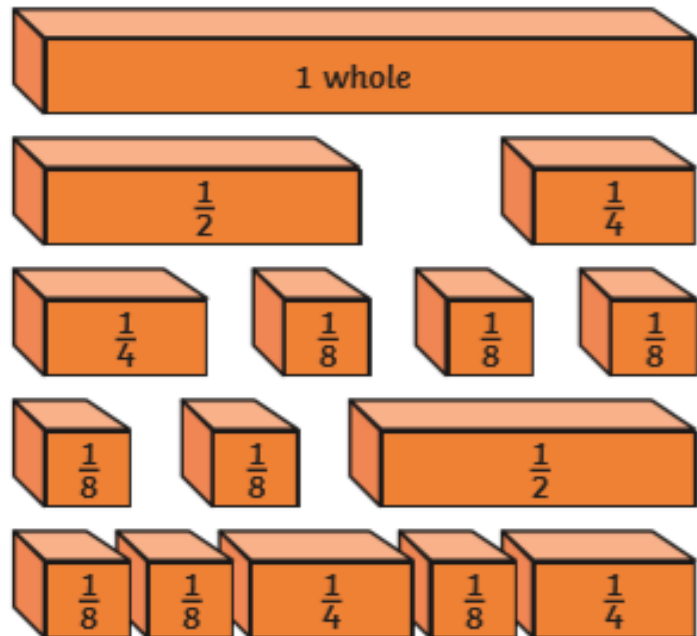


## Red
