Maths

Today we will be learning/revising how to use the grid method to multiply two digit numbers. This will build on the work we completed on Monday using partitioning.

Begin by spending ten minutes practising your times tables.

Then look at slide 1. This shows you how the work we did on Monday can be easier if we use the grid method - I will go through this on the Zoom in the morning.

Have a go at slide 2

For the main activity you will need two dice.

Throw the dice twice to create a two-digit number. You can then choose to throw the dice again to create a single digit number to multiply by, or multiply by 3 or 5 using the grids provided.

Complete as many as you need to until you are confident. Challenge yourself by multiplying by a trickier one digit number!

Have a go at the challenge on the last slide.
