Writing tasks:

	Lesson	Activity
Monday	Talk your child's own experiences of woods and their knowledge of traditional tales that feature woods. Find a selection of leaves, twigs, bark, fir cones etc. Create an imaginary wood scene using these props. What sounds might you hear? Use body percussion to make noises.	Ask your child to verbally construct a sentence that describes deep, dark woods thinking about what they might hear, what might live there. Ask you child to write it down using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Can they make their sentence even better by using adjectives or "and".
Tuesday	Look at the selection of woodland pictures. Create a list of adjectives thinking about how the objects in the wood look and feel (referring back to the props used yesterday to support).	Ask your child to write a description of the woods in one of the pictures.
Wednesday/ Thursday	Make a monster friend using either the template on the website, junk modelling materials or by drawing a monster. When complete, discuss the new monster friend. What makes a good friend? What is your monster friend like? Where does it live? What does it eat? What does it like to do with you?
