	Lesson	Activity
Monday	Look at a story book at home. Can you find any words with -ed endings? Write them down in a list. What do the words have in common? What do the words mean? Revise how adding -ed to a verb shows that something happened in the past.	-ed ending worksheet Children copy the root word and add the -ed ending. Challenge: to write sentences using these words
Tuesday	Watch the retelling of Little Red Riding Hood by clicking on the link below: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=sjKexWC8pnA Ask your child to retell the story to you in their own words.	Look at the pictures discuss what is happening in each one. Cut them out and stick them in order to make a Little Red Riding Hood book.
Wednesday/ Thursday	Look at the story book that was made yesterday. The children are going to write the story of Little Red Riding Hood using the pictures as prompts. Discuss what is happening in the picture. If needed, help your child compose the sentence that would be most appropriate. Remind your child to use finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. They should also now be able to join two sentences using "and". Challenge: to re-read what they have written and "be the teacher" making corrections with a different colour pen. They should decide if their sentences make sense, if they have used the correct spelling and remembered finger spaces, capital letters, full stops and "and".
