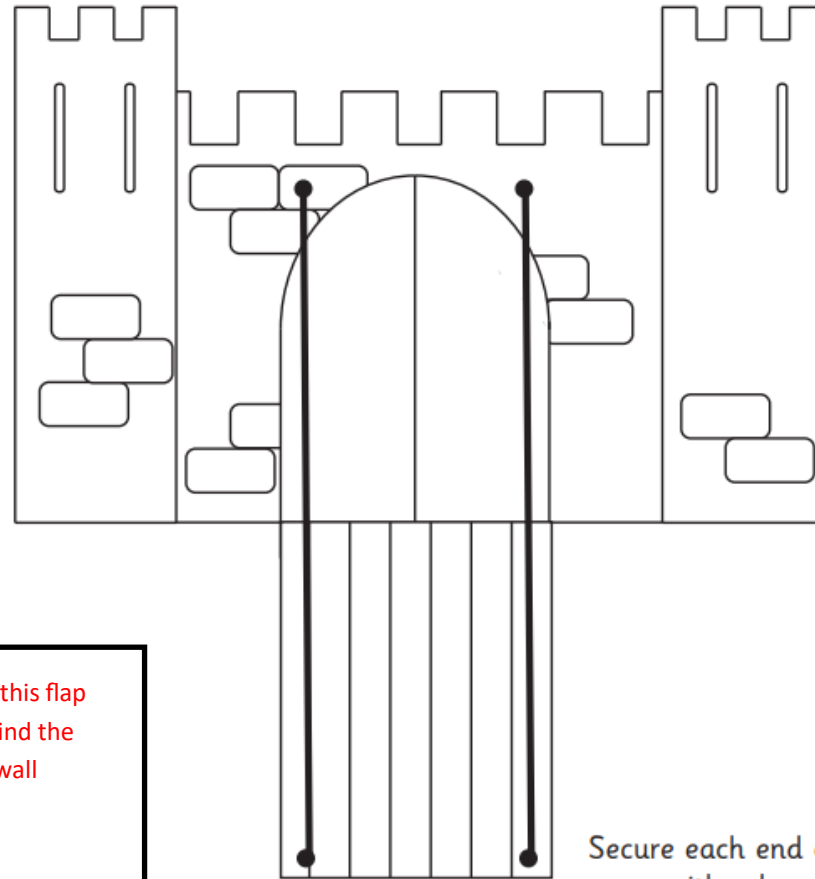

● = Use pencil or hole punch to insert small holes

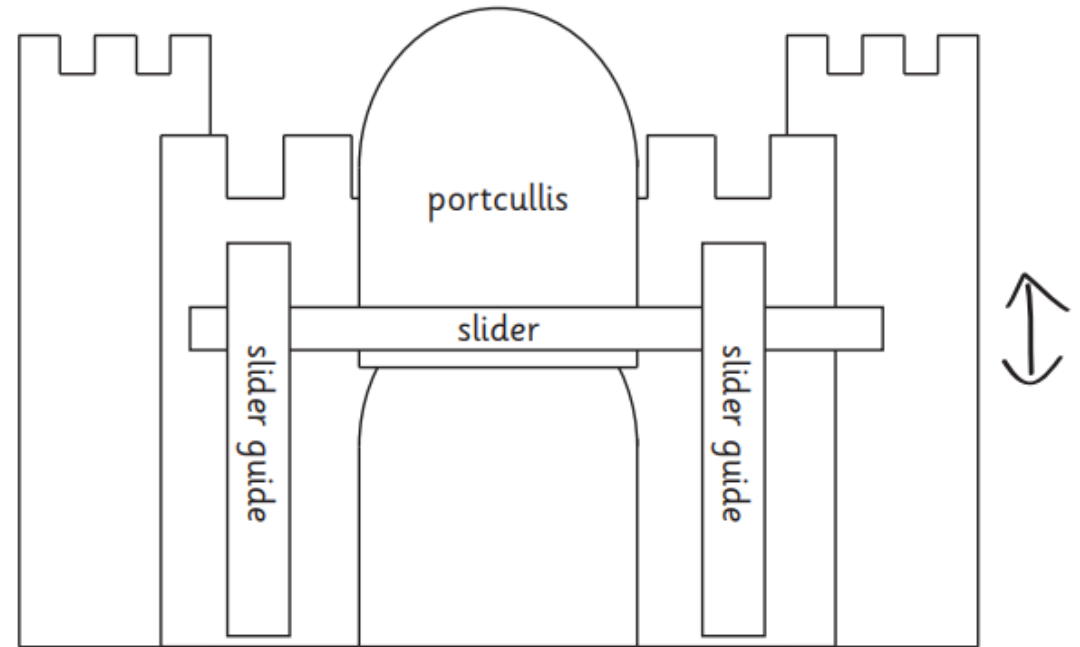
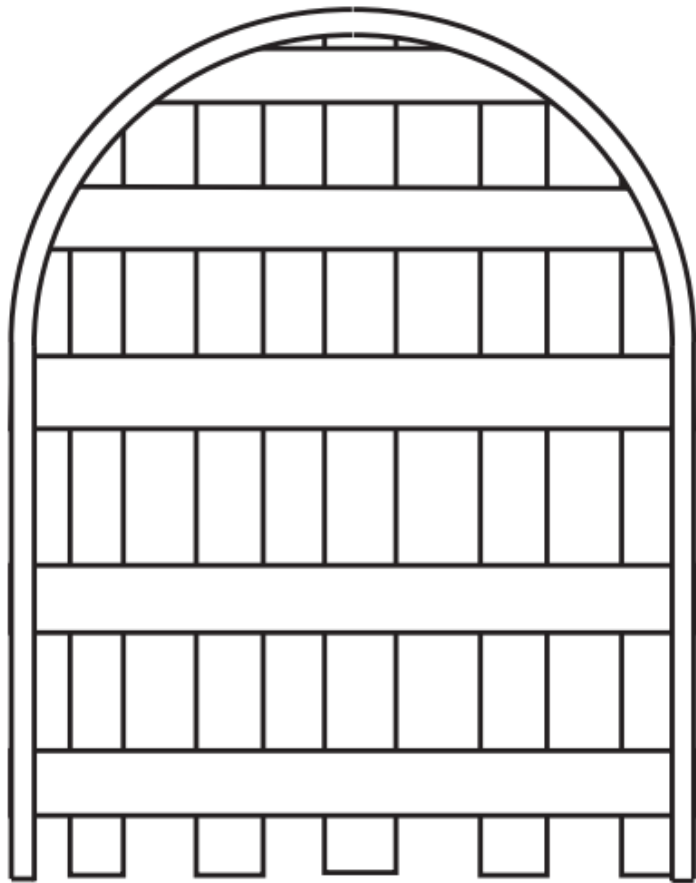
Thread string through the drawbridge holes and holes in the castle to allow the drawbridge to be raised and opened.

Cut out castle and drawbridge so that you can attach them together.

Please photocopy this resource onto card or attach to card to ensure it is strong enough.

Cut the door up the centre and part of the top so that it opens in two sections. To attach the drawbridge at the bottom, you will need to make extra flaps to attach it on either side of the door, snip on red line.





This is what the back of your castle should look like.

Cut out the castle and the portcullis. Cut out the doorway on the castle.

Cut 3 thin strips of card or cardboard out to use as the slider and guides to raise and close the portcullis.

Put a dab of glue at each end of 2 of the strips of card or use cellotape. Place these strips at either side of the doorway - see picture.

Attach one strip across the back of the portcullis (near the bottom). - See picture.

You should now be able to move the portcullis up and down by dragging the slider up and down, using the guides to hold the slider in place.
