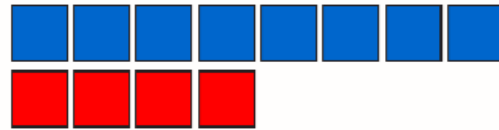


## How many more to make 8?

$$4 + \square = 8$$



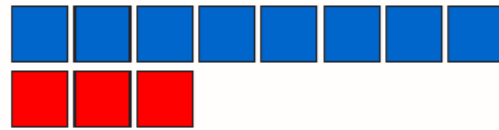
$$5 + \square = 8$$
