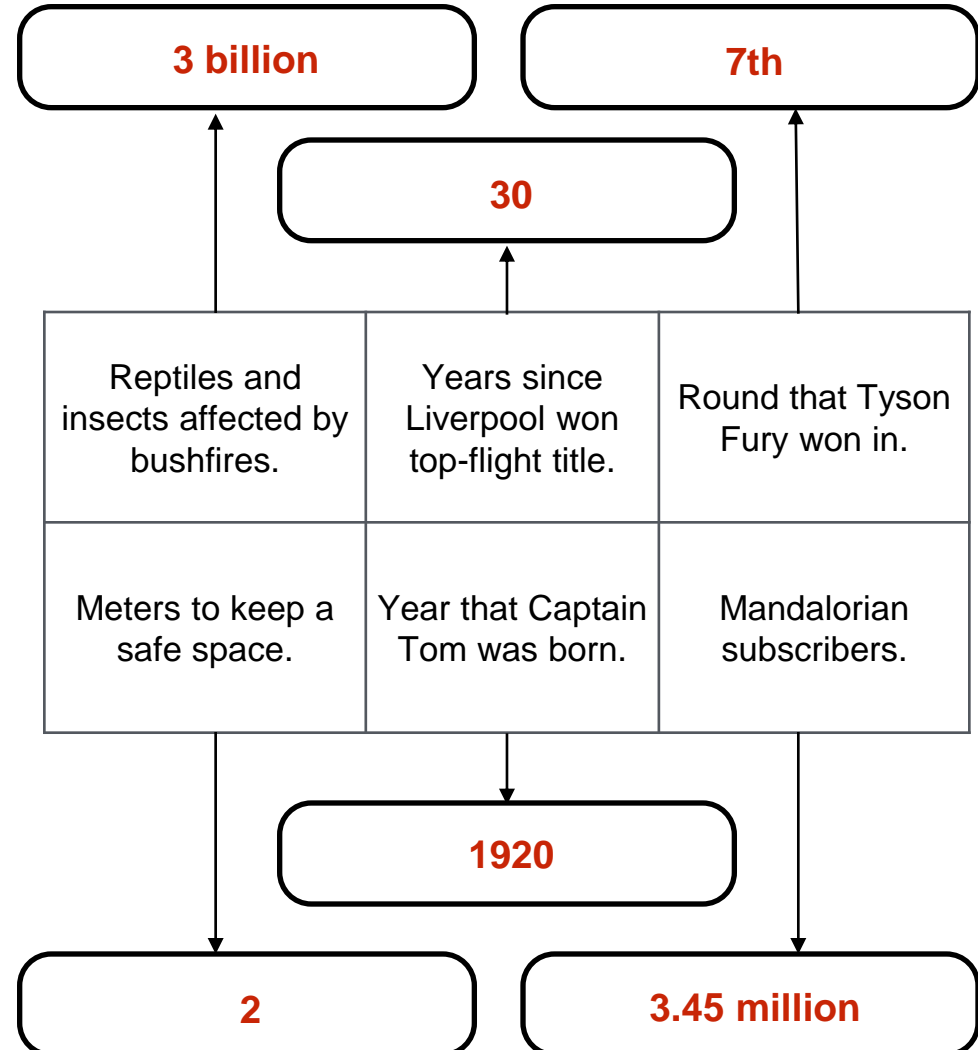

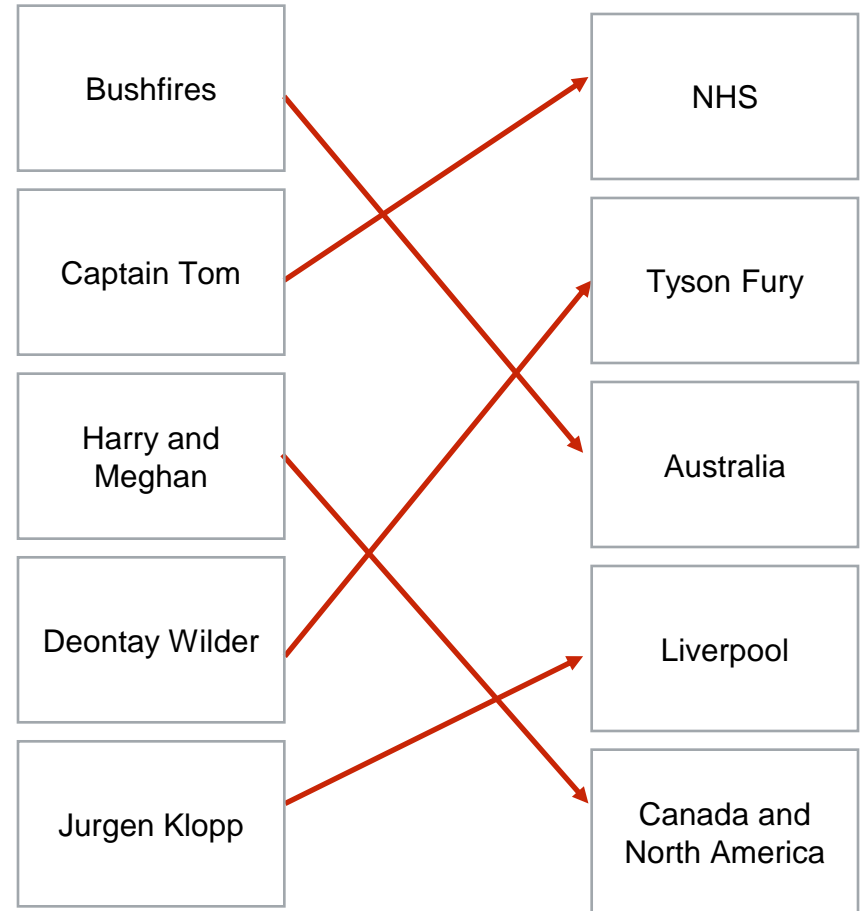

Devastating Bushfires in Australia

Australia has been devastated by terrible bushfires that have destroyed vast amounts of plants, trees and wildlife. As of March 9th 2020, 72,000 square miles of land has been destroyed, including over 5,900 buildings (2,779 homes) being incinerated. Experts believe that lightning strikes caused the fires to begin and they also believe that nearly 3 billion insects and reptiles will have been affected by the bushfires in New South Wales and Victoria. It is estimated that the general public generously donated over 500 million dollars to support the people and wildlife affected by the blaze.
