When we write something down, it is really important that other people can understand it!

Missing Word Mistakes

In this sentence, some of the words have been missed out so it doesn't make sense.
Can you add words in so that it makes sense?

Last week I to the park.

Last week I **went** to the park.



Spelling Mistakes

Can you spot and correct the spelling mistakes in this sentence?

Thay like gowing to the seaside.

They like going to the seaside.



Grammatical Mistakes

Sometimes, when we are writing, we choose the wrong words to go in the sentence.
Can you spot the mistake in this sentence?

They was having a good time.

They **were** having a good time.



Punctuation Mistakes

Can you spot where the full stop should be in these sentences?

I love my bike it is green with spots on it

I love my bike. It is green with spots on it



Each of these sentences has a mistake in it.
Can you spot them?

- Wen I went to the farm, I saw a hourse.
- She goed to the shops to but some sweets.
- It was sunny at beach.
- The car was red it went very fast.
