Regent's Park (Bakerloo Line): 20 min walk - follow signs through Regent's Park.

Baker Street (Bakerloo, Jubilee, Circle, Metropolitan and Hammersmith and City Lines): 15 min bus - Catch a 274 bus towards Camden Town.

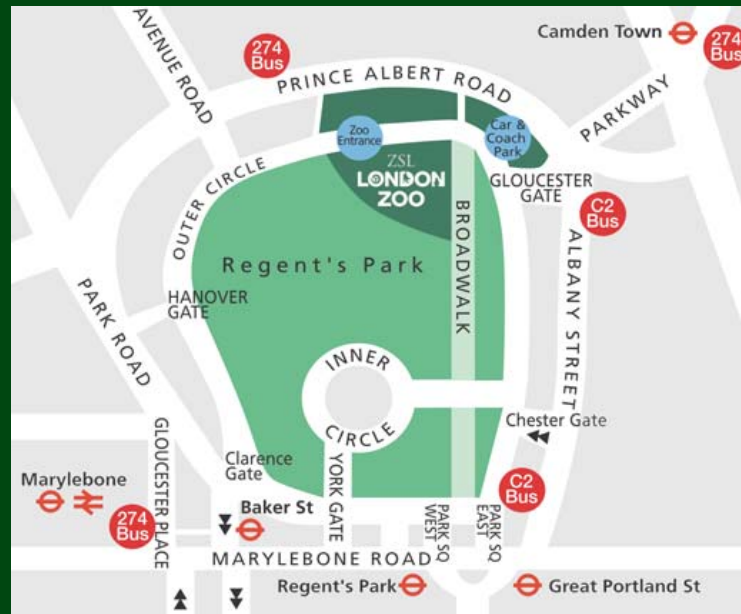
By waterbus

Visit Africa in the heart of London. Experience the sights, sounds and smells of the rainforest and get closer than ever to our gorillas.



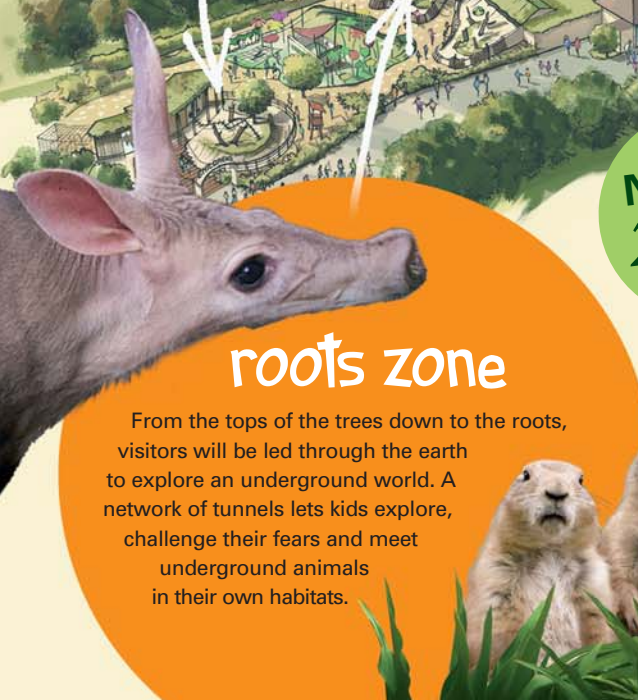
tree top zone

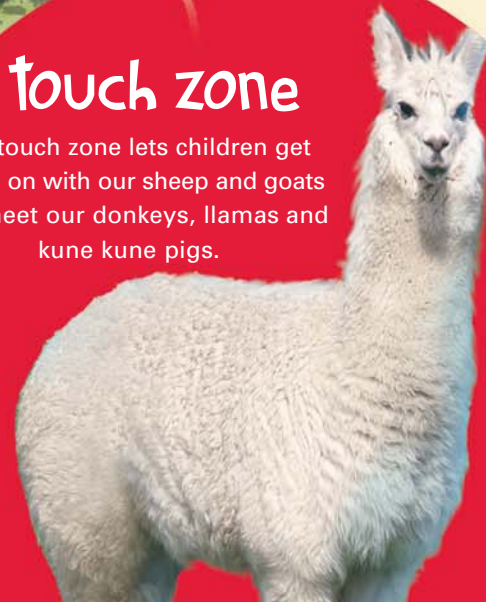
roots zone
