Enjoy the panorama from our very own the balcony overlooking the monkey orphanage.

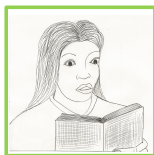

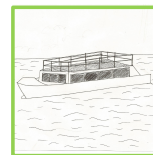
