

How to make perfect pancakes

You will need:

- **100g flour**
- **125ml milk**
- **Two eggs**
- **A little butter**
- **Toppings of your choice!**



Equipment:

A mixing bowl, a spoon, a cup, a plate and a frying pan.

What to do:

- 1. First, put the flour into the mixing bowl.**
- 2. Secondly, crack the two eggs into a cup and beat them.**
- 3. Then slowly pour the beaten eggs and the milk into the flour. Make sure you stir it well.**
- 4. Turn on the hob to a low heat.**
- 5. Next, melt a little butter in the frying pan, but be careful not to burn yourself.**
- 6. Pour enough mixture into the pan to make a thin pancake.**
- 7. After a few minutes, carefully toss or turn the pancake over to cook the other side.**
- 8. Check your pancake frequently to ensure that it does not burn.**
- 9. When it is golden serve the pancake on a plate and put on your favourite topping.**
- 10. Finally eat your perfect pancakes, but don't forget to do the washing up!**

TOP TIP

Don't forget to switch the hob off when you have finished.
