Ah Kin Mai	The priest.
Kintunyaabil	Sun intense all year, predicted by the prophets - a terrible year of drought.
Hetzmek	A ritual ceremony performed to welcome a new born baby in to the community.
Pok-a-tok	A famous ball game played by the Maya in Central America.
Uo	A Mayan frog found in the forest.
Quetzal (ket-zal)	A bird of central America, the feathers were used in royal costumes and ceremonial garments for kings.
Cenote (say-no-tay)	Open pits filled with water / underground caverns. Used for household needs and sacrificed to the gods.
Devour	Eat hungrily or quickly.
Consulted	Seek information or advice.
Perish	Die, especially in a violent or sudden way.
Marvelled	Be filled with wonder or astonishment.
Gourd	A fleshy, typically large fruit with hard skin.
Heralds	Messengers sent by monarchs.
Hence	As a consequence.
Counsel	Advice given.
Plight	A dangerous, difficult or unfortunate situation.

Whisked	To take or move in a direction suddenly and quickly.
