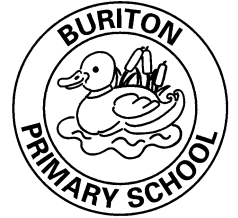




Art and Design Curriculum



INTENT

At Buriton Primary School, we believe that art, craft and design embody some of the highest forms of human creativity. Our high-quality art and design education engages, inspires and challenges our children and equips them with the knowledge and skills to experiment, invent and create their own works of art, craft and design. We aim to give our children the ability to think critically about art and design and understand how art and design both reflect and shape our history, and contribute to the culture, creativity, and wealth of our nation.

IMPLEMENTATION

Art activities are planned systematically in order to progressively build up skills and knowledge throughout the children's learning journey at Buriton Primary School. We ensure that all children are given opportunities to be inspired by the creative arts through community links and studies of a diverse range of professional artists and performers. During their education, pupils encounter a wide range of artists and artworks from different cultures, periods in history, and genders. We encourage exploration, individuality and team work, ensuring that children feel that their work is valued. Subject specific vocabulary is made explicit to encourage the language of art.

Risk and innovation are encouraged in all year groups, so that, rather than potentially constraining pupils' understanding and learning, they are enabled to be truly creative.

IMPACT

When pupils leave the Buriton Primary School, their learning in art will have enabled them to become confident, independent artists who can articulate and value their own creative journeys. They will be able to think critically and have developed a deep understanding of a range of art and design skills. The children will also understand how art and design has contributed to the cultural history of different periods and nations.
