Acceptable Use Agreement:
Pupils – in Key Stage One and
Foundation Stage

- ✓ I will not tell other people my ICT passwords.
- ✓ I will make sure that all ICT contact with other children and adults is kind and polite.
- ✓ I will not send or save anything unkind and if I see anything unpleasant I will tell the teacher.
- ✓ I will not give out my own details such as my name, phone number or home address.
- ✓ I will be responsible for my behaviour when using ICT because I know that these rules are to keep me safe.
- ✓ I know that my use of ICT can be checked by my teacher.

Key Stage 2 Pupil Acceptable Use /eSafety Agreement

- ✓ I will only use ICT in school for school purposes.
- ✓ I will not tell other people my ICT passwords.
- ✓ I will only open/delete my own files.
- ✓ I will make sure that all ICT contact with other children and adults is responsible, polite and sensible.
- ✓ I will not deliberately look for, save or send anything that could be unpleasant or unkind. If I accidentally find anything like this I will tell my teacher immediately.
- ✓ I will not give out my own details such as my name, phone number or home address.
- ✓ I will be responsible for my behaviour when using ICT because I know that these rules are to keep me safe.
- ✓ I know that my use of ICT can be checked and that my parent/ carer contacted if a member of school staff is concerned about my eSafety or my actions.
