What will my classroom be like?

You will have up to 15 children in your class and will be spread out on your tables. You will have all your resources provided for you so you don't need to share. Only Year 6 children will be allowed to bring in their own pencil case as long it is made of plastic or tin.



Where will I eat my lunch?

You will eat your lunch in your classroom with your friends and teacher. You can still order a lunch from the kitchen or you can bring in a packed lunch. Please bring in your own snack for playtime and don't forget your water bottle!



What will my lessons be like?

We will spend some time on an induction curriculum when you return. This will help you learn the new rules about being in school and will give you the chance to share your lockdown experience. You will also do some maths and English and lots of exciting things including PE.



Can I play outside?

Yes, each bubble will get to play in a different area of our school grounds supervised by an adult. It is important you have time to enjoy the fresh air and we are lucky with our outside area. Unfortunately you will not be able to use the Timbertrail.



How will I keep safe in school?

We have organised smaller class sizes for every class called bubbles. Each bubble will be its own 'family' and you won't contact with any other bubble. There are hand sanitisers in every room and you will be reminded regularly to wash your hands.



Will I wear school uniform?

Yes, you do have to wear school uniform except on PE days when you can come to school already in your PE kit. I suggest a sun hat, sun cream and sunglasses might be a good idea when sunny, also a light waterproof jacket in case rains. Don't forget to have your name written on your clothes!
